Japan-Russia Approchement: Why Abe-Putin Summits Failed to Deliver

Introduction

Since he returned to power for the second time in 2012, Japan's Prime Minister Shinzo Abe has been the most active force behind Japan's return to international leadership. One might say he has what we call the Japanese Prime Minister's habit: to restore the full integrity of Japanese territory by securing the status of the Northern Territories to Japan.

Abe's visit to Moscow from April 28-30, 2017 was the starting point for the present phase of Japan-Russia relations. On March 2, 2012, then Vice Prime Minister and now retired President of Russia, Vladimir Putin, stated that he wanted to restore relations with Japan to developmental cooperation and beyond the territorial issue on the basis of a "four-point solution" - a term borrowed from their state constitutions. Russia has long history of a solution to the territorial issue that was not a solution for other side but a compromise.

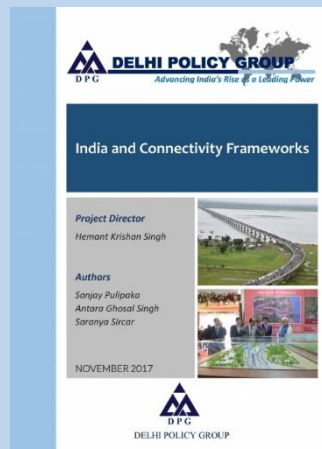
