



# DPG-JIIA 7th India-Japan Indo-Pacific Forum (10th India-Japan Track 1.5 Dialogue)

"India and Japan: Partners for Asian Stability and Progress"

New Delhi, November 18-19, 2024

#### **Event Profile**

The Delhi Policy Group (DPG) and the Japan Institute of International Affairs (JIIA), as mandated anchor institutions, will convene the 7<sup>th</sup> annual India-Japan Indo-Pacific Forum (10<sup>th</sup> India-Japan Track 1.5 Dialogue) in New Delhi on November 18-19, 2024, with the support of MEA (India) and MOFA (Japan).

The objective of this Track 1.5 dialogue, bringing together strategic experts from think tanks and academia with government officials from both sides, is to deepen intellectual exchanges, enhance understanding of each other's national aspirations and regional objectives, and foster a deeper bilateral partnership based on mutual trust and shared interests, thereby contributing to Indo-Pacific order, stability and prosperity.

Since the previous edition of the dialogue, which was held in Tokyo on November 15-16, 2023, challenges to international peace and stability have become more formidable as conflicts and great power competition have escalated, resulting in pervasive volatility in the international system. The need to prioritise dialogue and diplomacy to resolve conflicts and disputes peacefully in accordance with international law, and for all nations to refrain from attempts to unilaterally change the status quo, has never been greater.

At this juncture, as Asia's leading democracies committed to the rule of law, India and Japan bear special responsibility to champion and uphold a global order based on the principles and purposes of the UN Charter, international law, respect for the sovereignty and territorial integrity of all states, and sustainable development of all nations. They must also redouble their efforts to ensure a free and open Indo-Pacific that is stable, secure and prosperous.

The combined efforts of India and Japan can help build broader and more inclusive convergences on international security and cooperation, including among the emerging powers of the Indo-Pacific and the nations of the Global South.





The strategic vision laid out with great eloquence and clarity in 2007 by Japan's former Prime Minister, the late Shinzo Abe, in his words: "A strong India is in the best interest of Japan, and a strong Japan is in the best interest of India", continues to guide bilateral relations. To provide mutual reinforcement to each other as strategic partners and bolster regional stability, India and Japan are making efforts to become better aligned on the critical security issues of the Indo-Pacific. They are investing in their own defence capabilities and enhancing bilateral defence cooperation.

The positive outcomes of the India-Japan 2+2 Ministerial Meeting held in New Delhi on August 20, 2024, including the decision to prepare an updated framework for security cooperation in keeping with contemporary realities, augur well.

Going forward, India and Japan will also need to raise the level of their overall partnership, taking into account evolving national goals and priorities.

Given the still untapped opportunities of the bilateral economic relationship, there is need to deepen dialogues for greater cooperation in the areas of trade, investment, economic security, and trust-based collaboration in critical and emerging technologies.

People-to-people exchanges remain a vital area for transforming India-Japan relations, which calls for sharper focus on building ties across the inter-related realms of language, culture, education, tourism, skilling and manpower mobility. Travel between India and Japan must be made easier, through reciprocal and harmonised visa regimes covering all categories of travel.

Against this backdrop, the 7<sup>th</sup> Indo-Pacific Forum will seek to forge a broad understanding on the convergent interests and the joint contributions of India and Japan as strategic partners for Indo-Pacific stability and progress.

The first of its closed-door sessions on the global order will enhance understanding of the geostrategic positioning of India and Japan amidst great power contestation and changing power balance. The second closed-door session will assess India-Japan convergences, contributions, and the role of the Quad in bolstering Indo-Pacific stability, security and prosperity. The third closed-door session will deliberate on accelerating bilateral relations across the realms of security, technology and people-to-people relations.

The concluding open/public session of the Forum will aim to disseminate to the wider national and regional audiences perspectives on the rise of Asia and the Indo-Pacific in global order, as well as the outlook for greater strategic coordination between India and Japan.

In keeping with established practice, the general trend of deliberations at the 7<sup>th</sup> India-Japan Indo-Pacific Forum will be summarised in a DPG-JIIA Joint Statement.
